From Lavant, enjoy a stroll, run or cycle ride along the beautiful tree-lined route of Centurion Way, taking you all the way to Chichester.

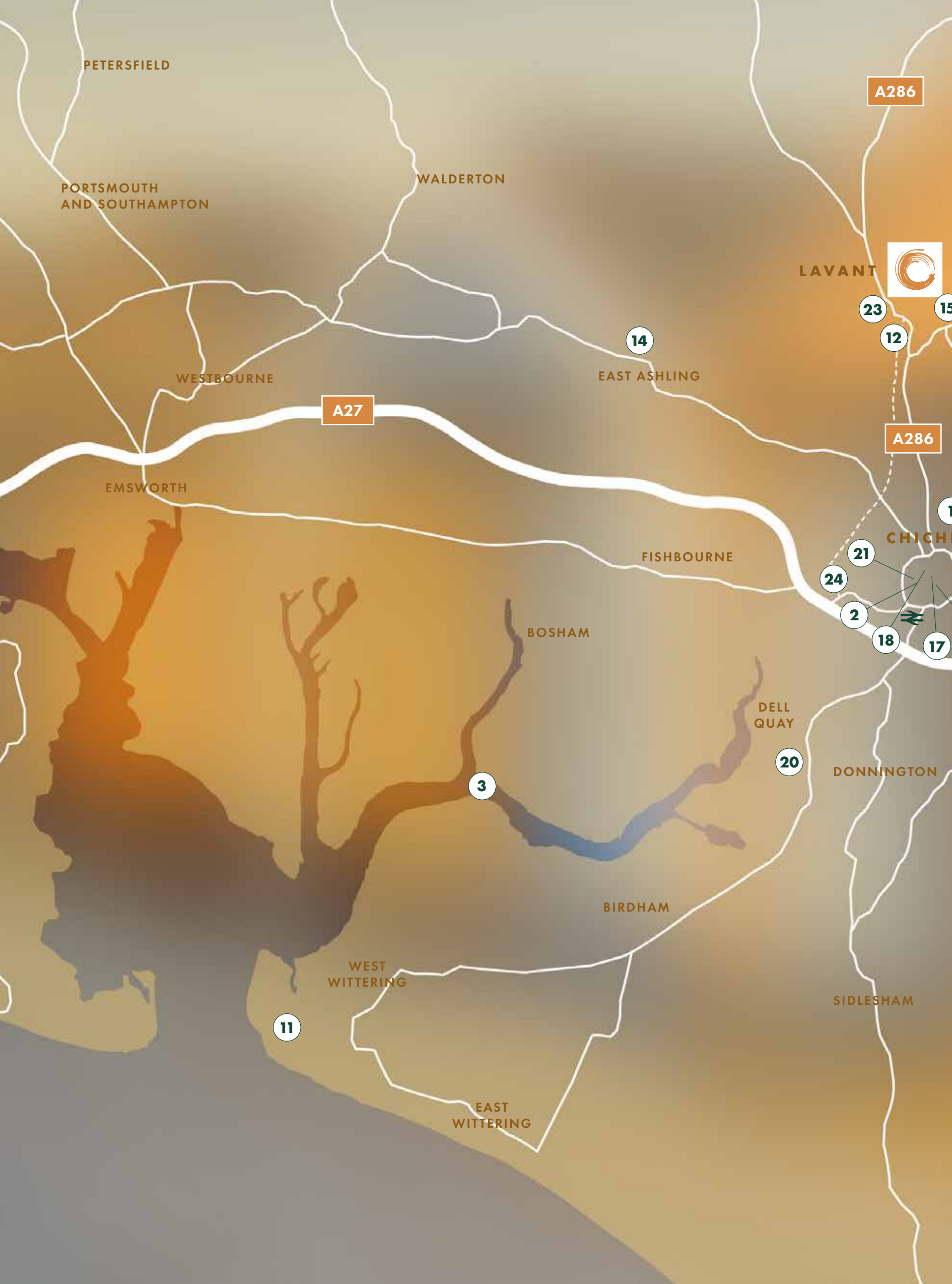

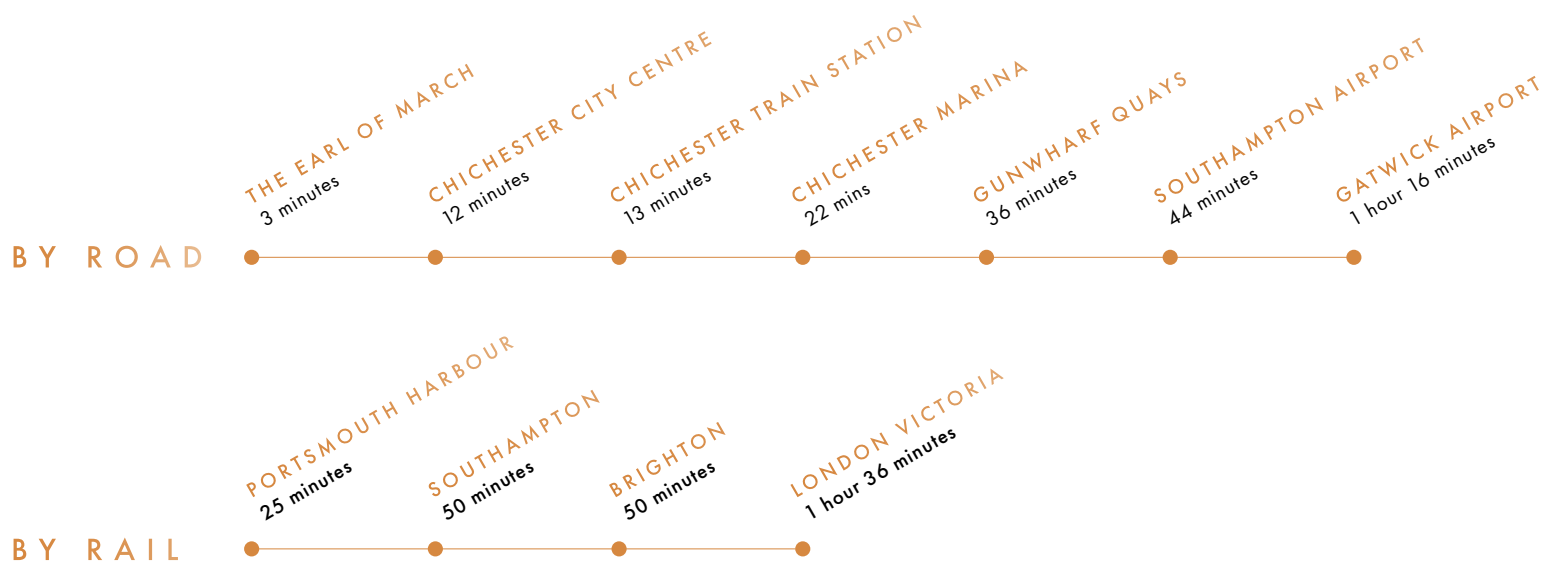

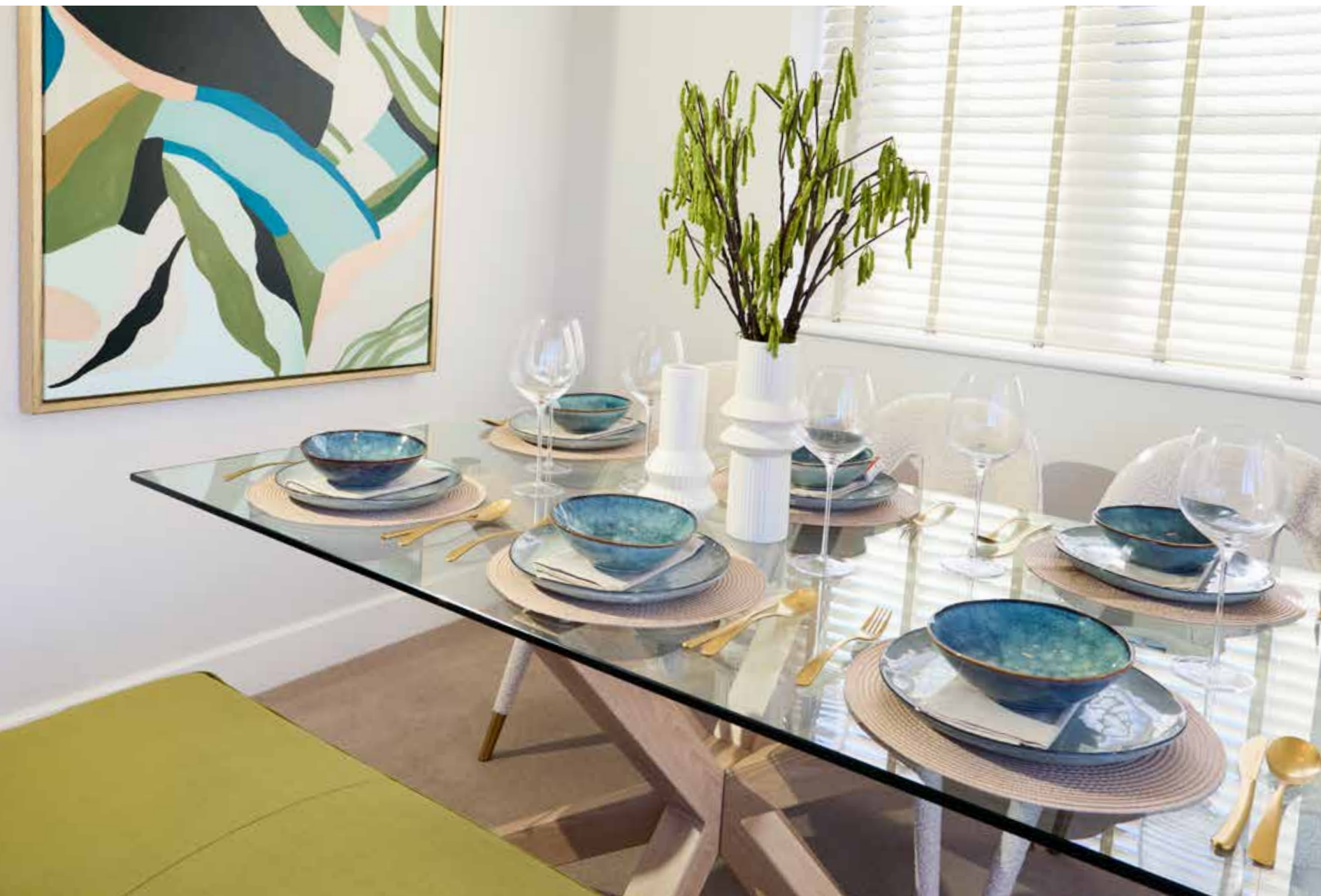
